


Government's OSS Objectives

- Address the issues of Intellectual Proprietary Rights effectively
- Decrease deployment costs in education and government sector

Open Source Resource Center

- Develop a community for open source
- Hold workshops over Open Source Development in all major cities
- Create a network of Open Source developers
- Groom an environment of Open Source Development in Pakistan
- Encourage OSS R&D activities in local universities with international collaboration



STRATEGY

- Mobilize the OSS practicing community (through OSRC web-portal & academia)
- Conduct Training/Awareness workshops (ensuring local industry participation)
- Promote OSS in industry (seminars, training material, discussion forums, network with hardware/software vendors)
- Build in-house support capability
- Back-up support on solution(s) given to the industry on OSS

- Developing a graduate level course on OSS to be introduced in local universities.
