

# **GoP's Philosophy on Open Source**

- Define Requirements independent of Technology
  - Adopt standards that allow Interoperability
    - Increase Opportunity for Participation
      - Match technology with need
  - Where necessary use Proprietary solutions
  - Where possible use Open Source solutions
- Considering, Upfront cost, TCO, Support, Usability, Scalability,
  Robustness, Integration, etc.



# **Factors Driving GoP's OSS Initiative**

- Affordability
- Local Employment Generation
  - Respect for IPRs
- Reduce vendor dependencies.

# **Linux Administration Training Program**

- Under this program training would be imparted to the technical employees of the Federal and Provincial Governments at Islamabad/Rawalpindi and all the Provincial Headquarters including AJK and Ex-Divisional Headquarters of Punjab, Sindh, NWFP and Baluchistan.
- The project has been prepared on the demands of the Federal and Provincial Governments. It will be extremely helpful in the introduction of E-Government and will improve administrative efficiency and office productivity



#### **Industrial Automation**

- PSEB's "Automation of Domestic Industry on Open Source Systems" project is engaged in developing complete ERP solutions to automate the processes and procedures for the SMEs in HR & Payroll, Finance, Inventory, Production and Sales in those sectors of the economy with the highest export potential.
- The ERP solutions are being developed using open source software. The ERP will be made available to the industry, so that applications can be further enhanced as per the needs of the units



#### **Electronic Government Directorate**


- Implementation of different projects related to the Electronic Government (E-Govt) Programme.
- Provide technical advice & guidelines for implementation of Egovernment projects at the Federal, Provincial and District levels;
- Plan and prepare Electronic government projects
- Provide standards for software and infrastructure in the field of Electronic Government; and
- To undertake any other assignment matter that the government may direct.

- Groom an environment of Open Source Development in Pakistan
- Encourage OSS R&D activities in local universities with international collaboration




- Voluntary support groups add value but have certain limitations




